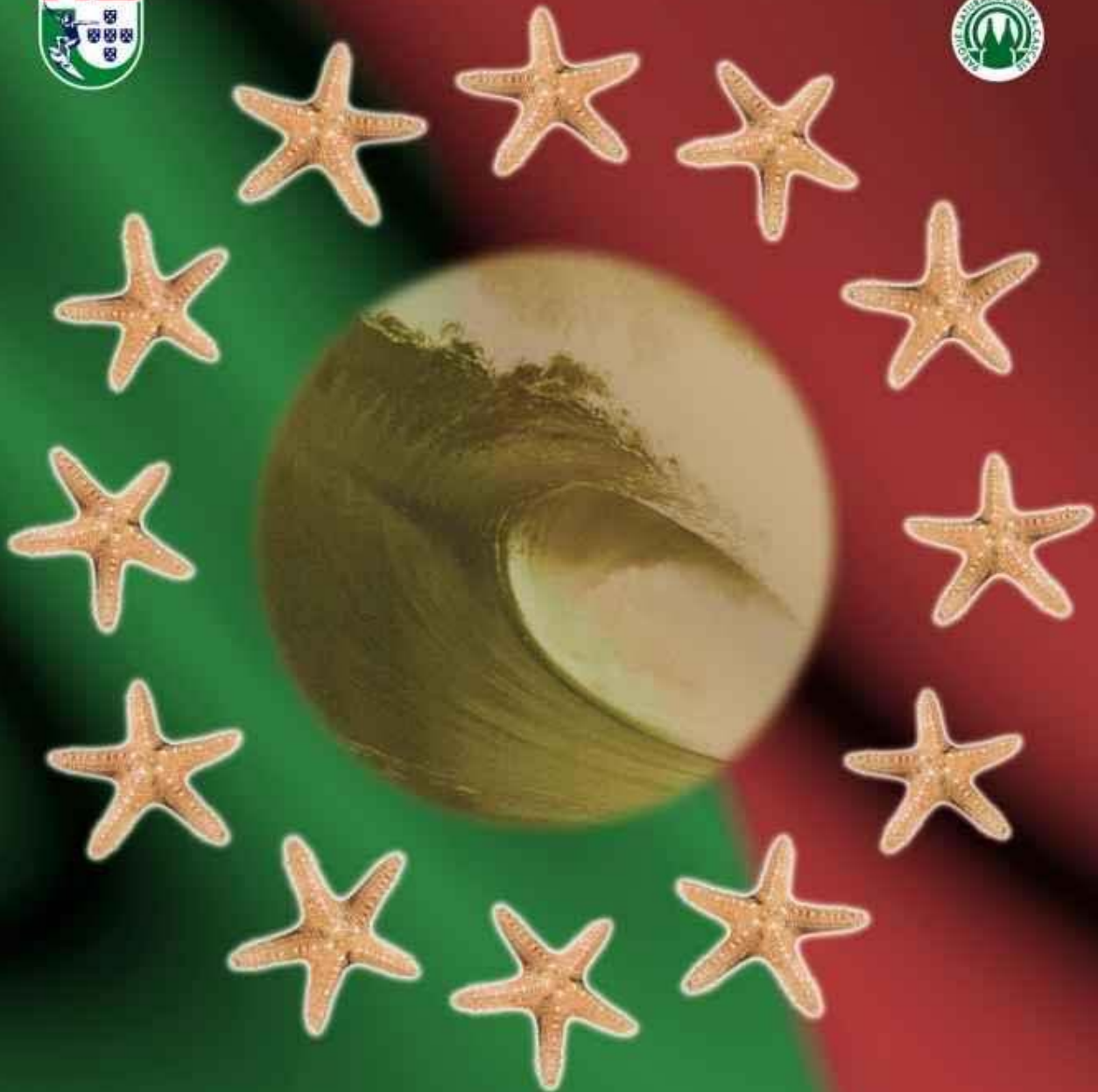

## **Technical Meetings**

After all teams have arrived and before the Welcome Party on the second day, locations will be provided to host the three meetings of the technical staff members: Judges Coaches and Team Managers

## **Welcome Party**

This Party is meant to gather all European competitors in a friendly Portuguese atmosphere, with traditional food and music, not to go on after 11pm.

## **Opening Ceremony**

This is a Ceremony similar to the Olympic Parade of the Nations.

All the guests, VIP's, Media and Sports Officials will be assembled in a special place, in Sintra.

The Parade will start a few hundred meters away, and will march, through an itinerary previously coordinated with police authorities, to the place where Officials are gathered.

Countries will parade by alphabetic order, with the Portuguese Team closing the procession. Each delegation will be preceded by a girl scout carrying the countries' Flags.

The ceremonial speeches will take place after the Parade

## **The Event**

Upon the arrival of teams and during all competition days, breakfast and dinner will be available to all competitors, in the accommodation place, at the Wondertur Turistic Complex.

Breakfast will take place between 7 and 9 am, subject to confirmation by the Technical Director.

Dinner will be served in 3 rounds of 50 minutes, between 7 and 9:30.

Countries will be divided in three groups A, B and C, which will rotate every day - for example, on day one Group A dines at 7:00pm, Group B at 7:50, Group C at 8:40; on day two, the order is B, C, A; on day three C, A, B... and so on.

Competition will start on Sunday, September 5, after the Press Conference and Lunch, and will go on for eight consecutive days until Sunday, September 12.

Competition timings are subject to confirmation by the Contest Director.

The whole competition will be run simultaneously on two different sites within walking distance of which other.

A training area will be kept available for all competitors, near the two competition sites.

## **Finals**

The Finals will take place Sunday, September 5, at the Main Competition Podium.
